

## Kindergarten Homework Rubric

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<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• writes first name, last name, and date on each worksheet</li> <li>• neat handwriting, attending to size, form, and line placement</li> <li>• neat drawings with details and pictures are colored</li> <li>• sight words are consistently spelled correctly on any type of homework</li> <li>• child writes one sentence per sight word on sight word worksheet</li> <li>• 2-3 unknown words on questioning/vocabulary sheet are spelled correctly</li> <li>• question on questioning/vocabulary sheet is about the content of the story (something they wonder about that is specifically important to the storyline)</li> <li>• narrative/opinion writings include at least 4 sentences and follow the guidelines for each genre</li> <li>• draws all parts of the story map (setting – time/place, character, character’s problem, 3 events, ending/how problem was solved)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• handwriting is legible, but size, form, and line placement is inconsistent</li> <li>• drawings are less detailed and/or are not colored</li> <li>• sight words are inconsistently spelled correctly on any type of homework</li> <li>• child writes 3-4 sentences, but does not have one sentence per sight word</li> <li>• 1-3 unknown words on questioning/vocabulary sheet are spelled incorrectly</li> <li>• question on questioning/vocabulary sheet is about something insignificant to the storyline</li> <li>• narrative/opinion writings include 3- 4 sentences and do not follow the guidelines for each genre</li> <li>• draws most (5-7) parts of the story map (setting – time/place, character, character’s problem, 3 events, ending/how problem was solved)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• handwriting is illegible or writing does not attend to size, form, and line placement</li> <li>• drawings are not included, or include little to no detail and are not colored</li> <li>• sight words are frequently spelled incorrectly on any type of homework</li> <li>• child writes 0-2 sentences on the sight word sheet</li> <li>• less than 2 unknown words are identified on the questioning/vocabulary sheet and are spelled incorrectly</li> <li>• no question on questioning/vocabulary sheet is included or a statement is written</li> <li>• narrative/opinion writings include only 1-2 sentences and do not follow the guidelines for each genre</li> <li>• draws some (4 or less) parts of the story map (setting – time/place, character, character’s problem, 3 events, ending/how problem was solved)</li> </ul>
